## 918 Learners

Over 900 learners came together to learn how to build their very own browser extensions using Javascript! Over 87% of our learners identified as female. Together, we wrote ~24,786 lines of code!



## 27 Cities

From St. John's to Victoria, in small towns to big cities, we hosted 30 workshops across 10 provinces with our average learner aged 41-55. Combined, we spent over 4,500 hours learning to code!



## 259 Technical Mentors

Our 4:1 ratio of learners to mentors makes all of the difference. This year, our incredible community of volunteers helped learners get the most out of the day by donating over 1,295 hours of their time!
