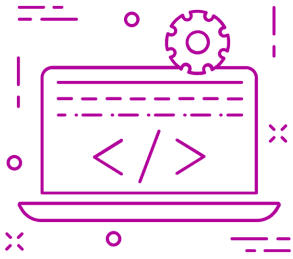

One task: learn how to build a browser extension with JavaScript



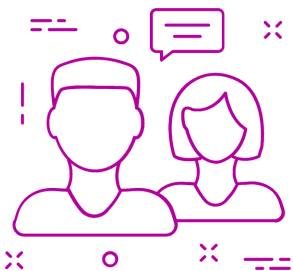
918 Learners
